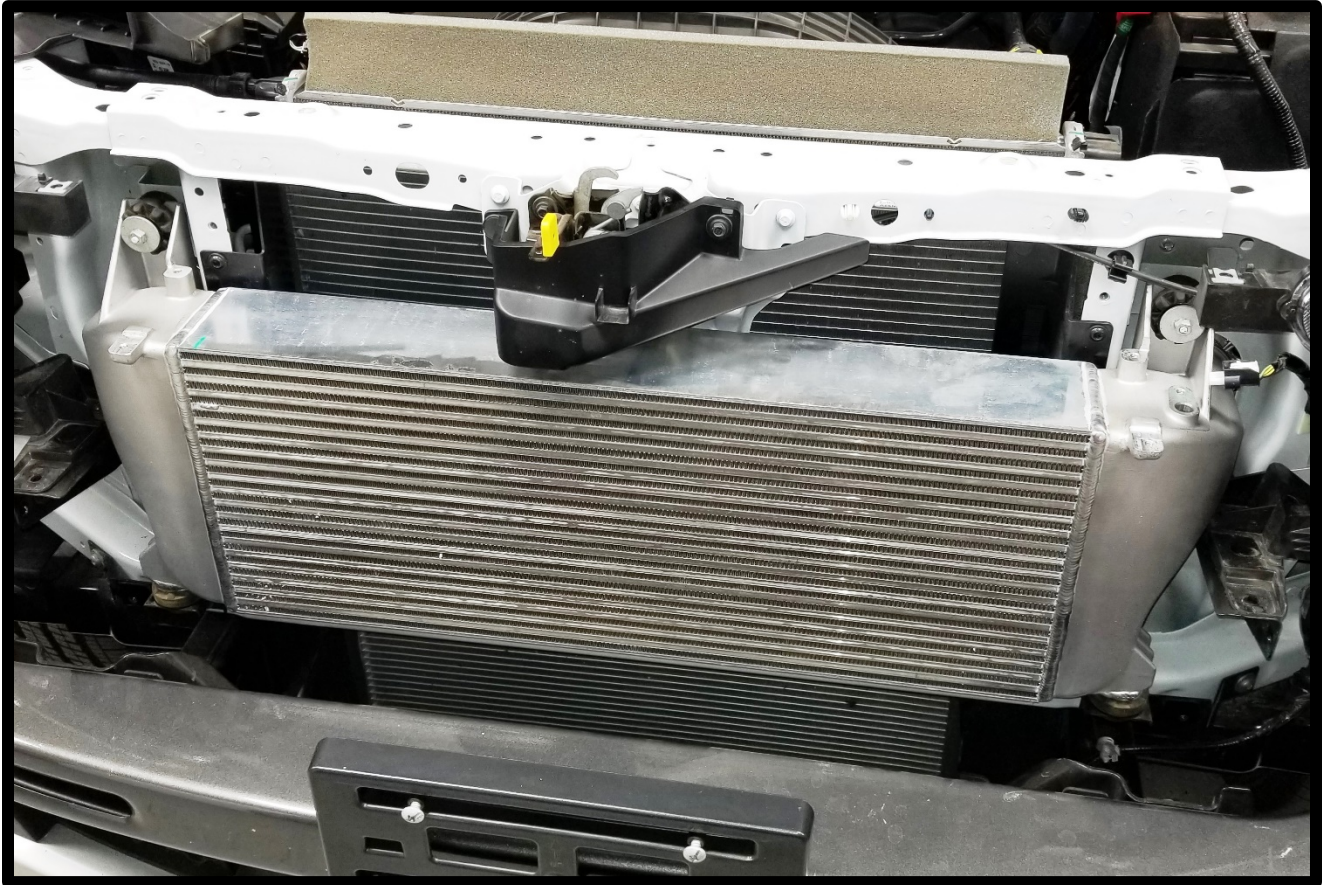

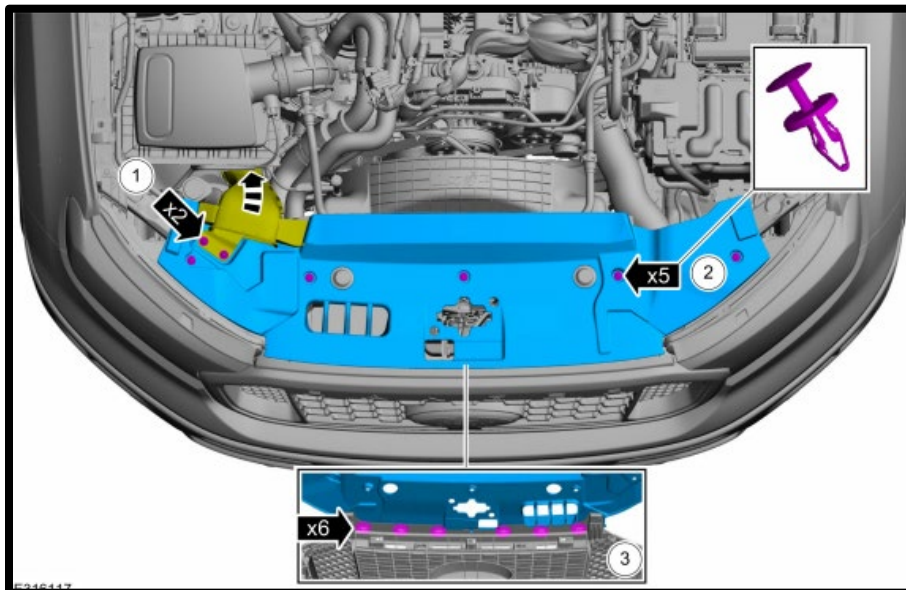

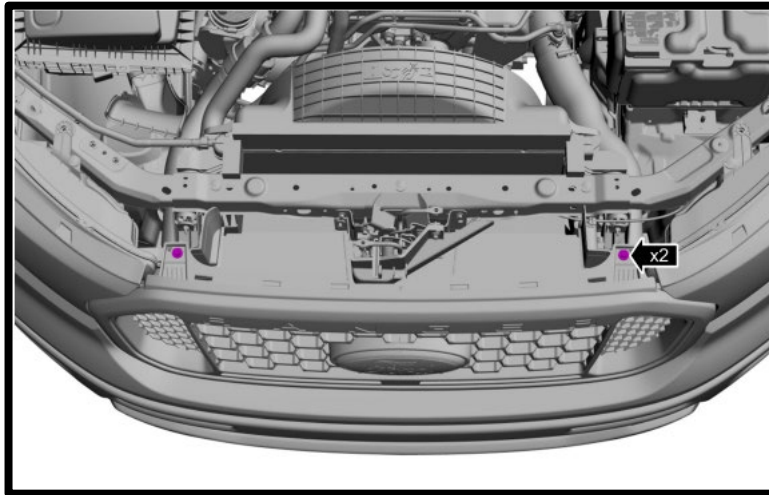
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

It is strongly recommended that you read through this guide **before** you begin modifying your vehicle.

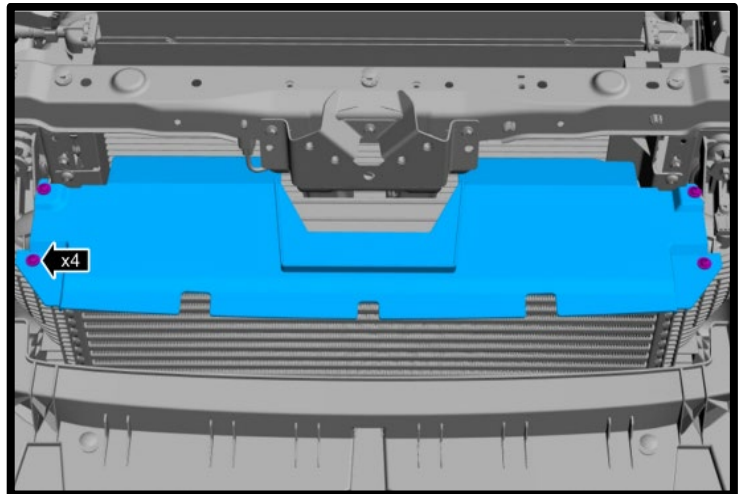
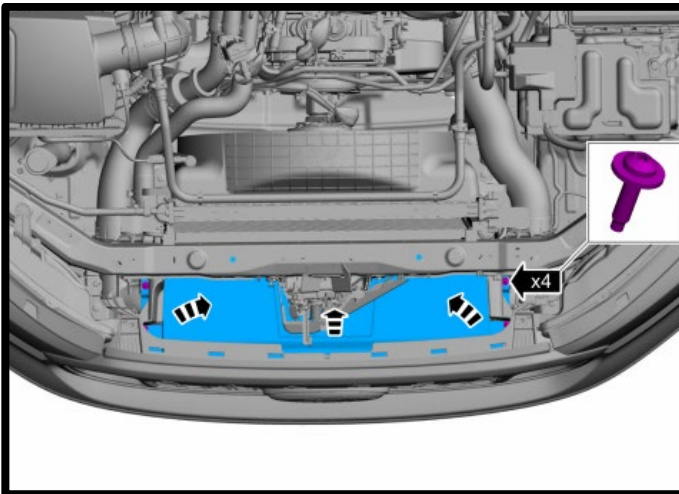
1. Disconnect the (-) negative cable from the battery, secure ground wire so it cannot arc.
2. Remove the (5) retainers from radiator shield and the (2) fasteners from the air intake duct. Release the tabs and remove the radiator sight shield.



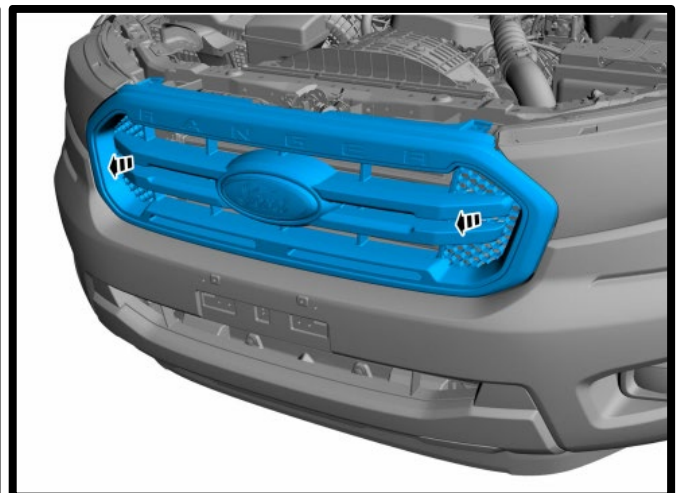
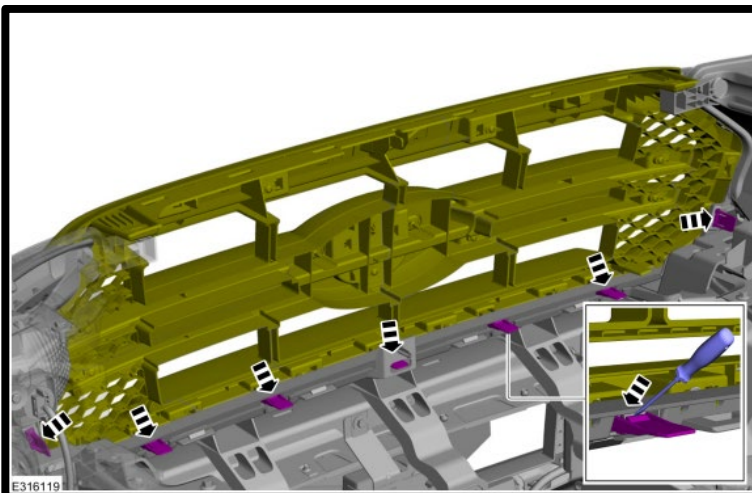
3. Remove the (2) bolts from grill.



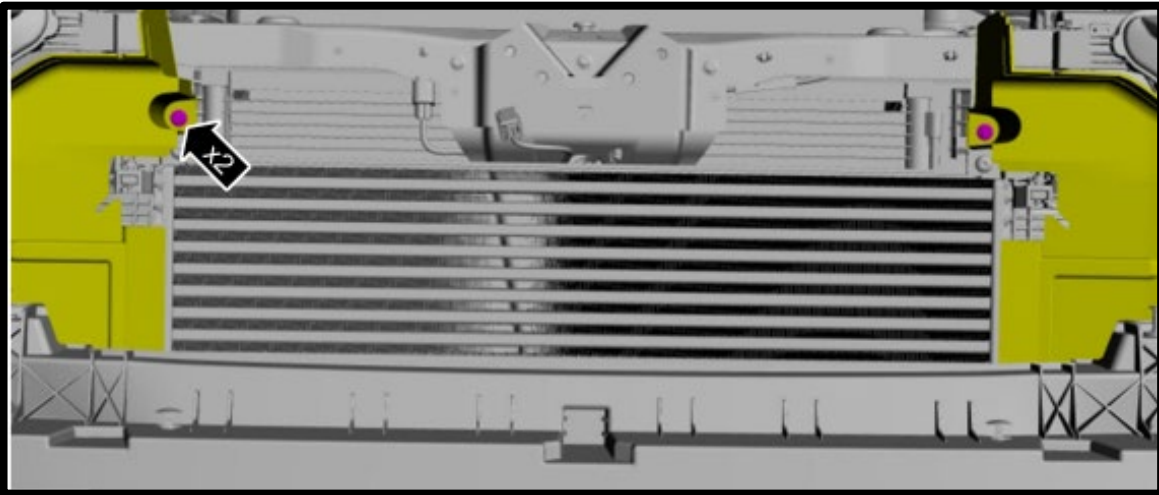
4. Remove the (4) screws and the radiator upper shield.



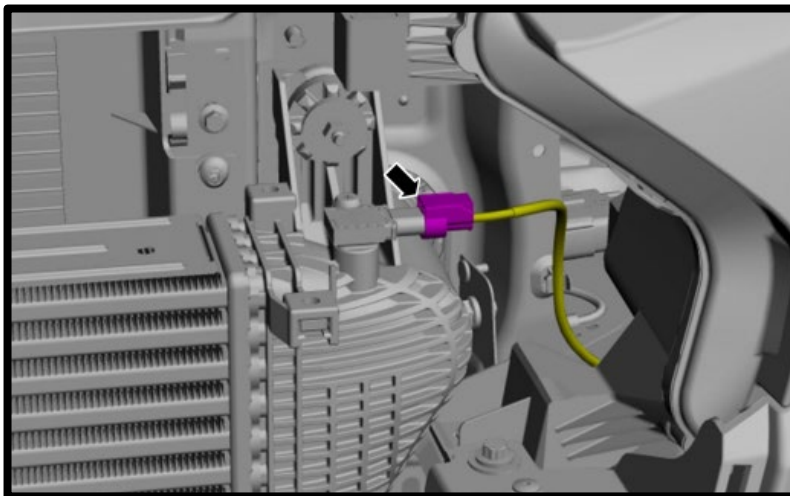
5. Using a flat blade screwdriver, release the locking tabs from front bumper. Remove the grille from vehicle.



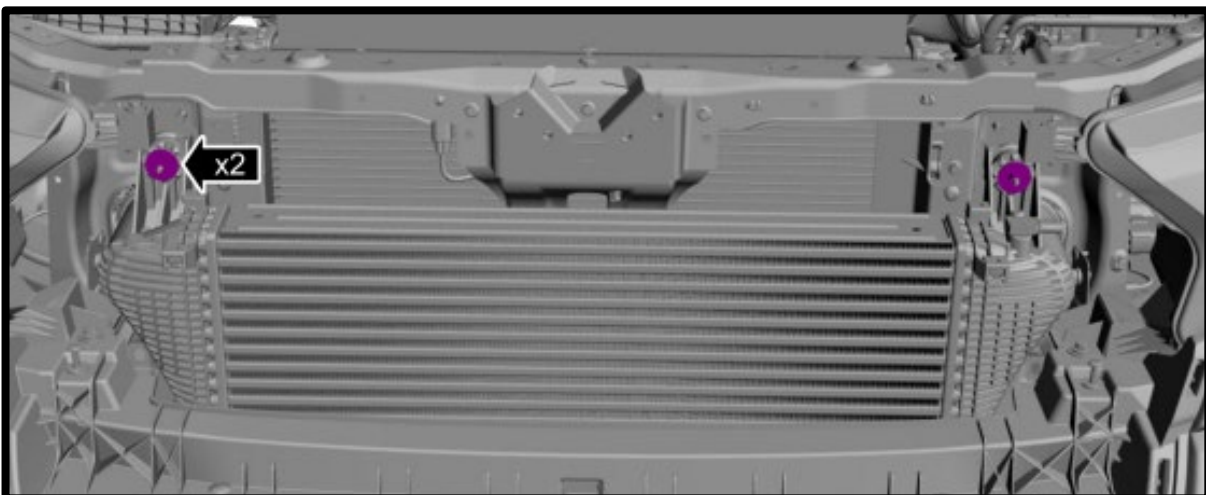
6. Remove the (2) fasteners from air deflectors.



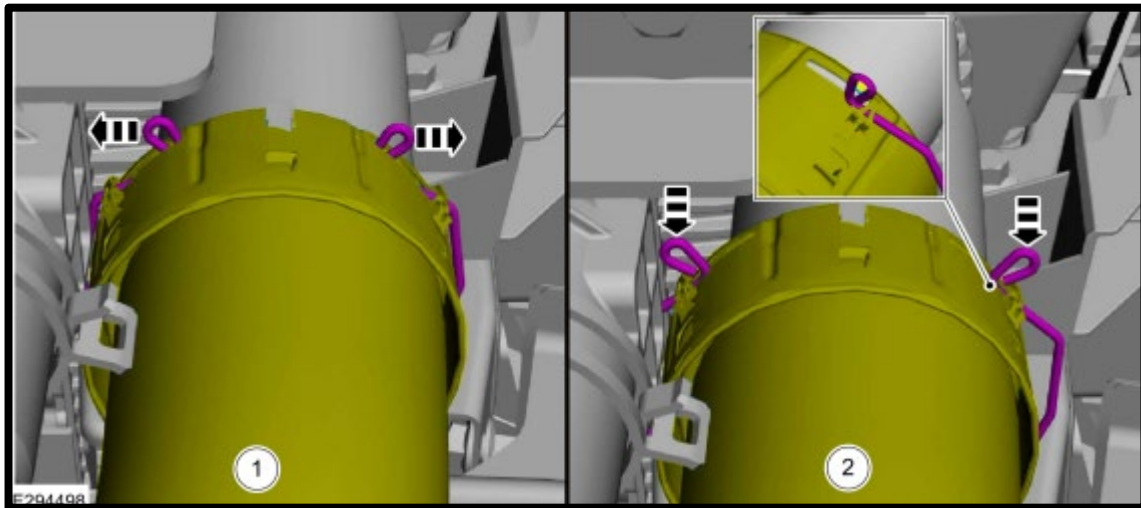
7. Disconnect the turbocharger boost pressure sensor electrical connector.



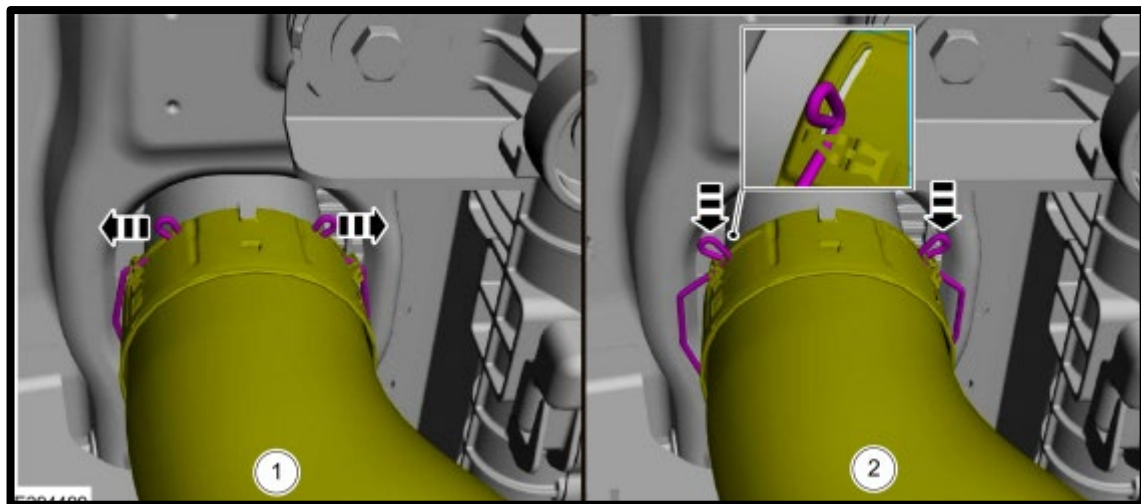
8. Remove the (2) fasteners securing intercooler to vehicle.



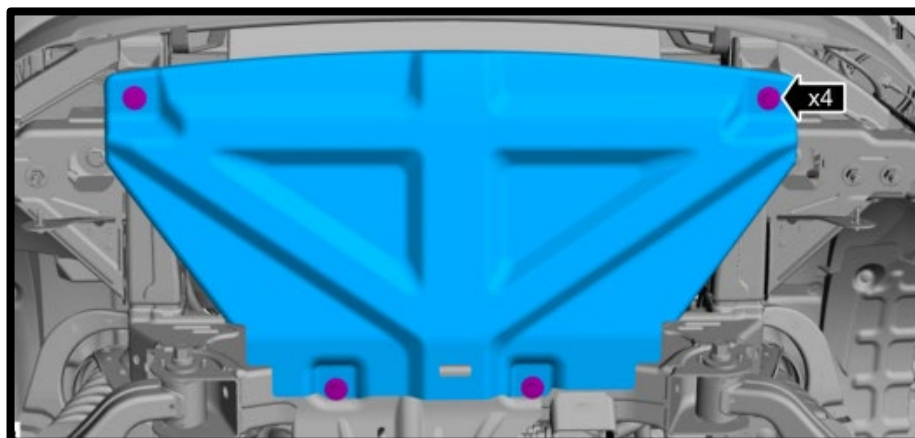
9. Release the CAC inlet pipe by spreading the retainer ends outward.



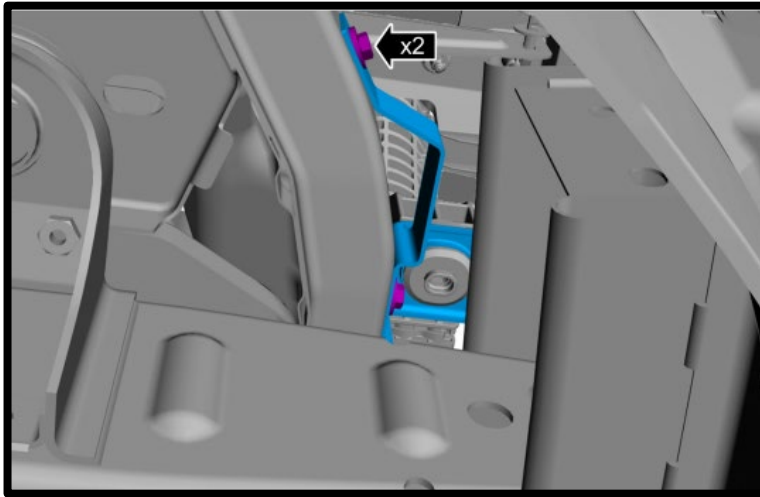
10. Position the retainer ends in the notches locking the retainer in the open position and position aside the CAC outlet pipe.



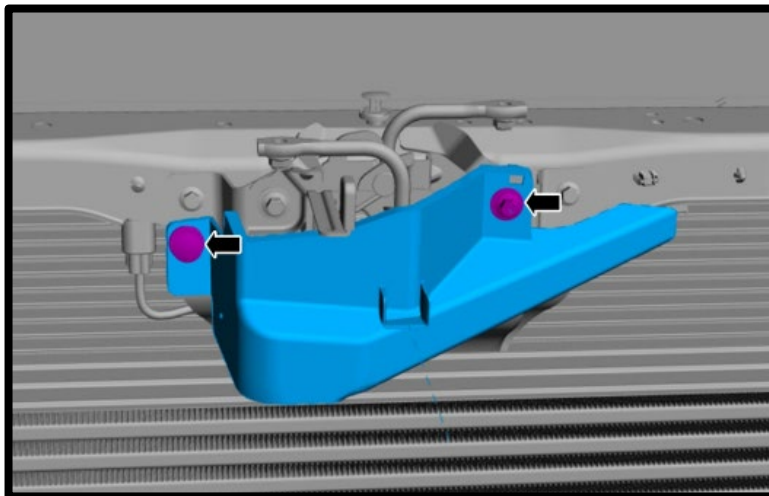
11. Remove the (4) fasteners and front skid plate. If proper access to skid plate is not available, jack the vehicle up, install jack stands using the factory lifting points.



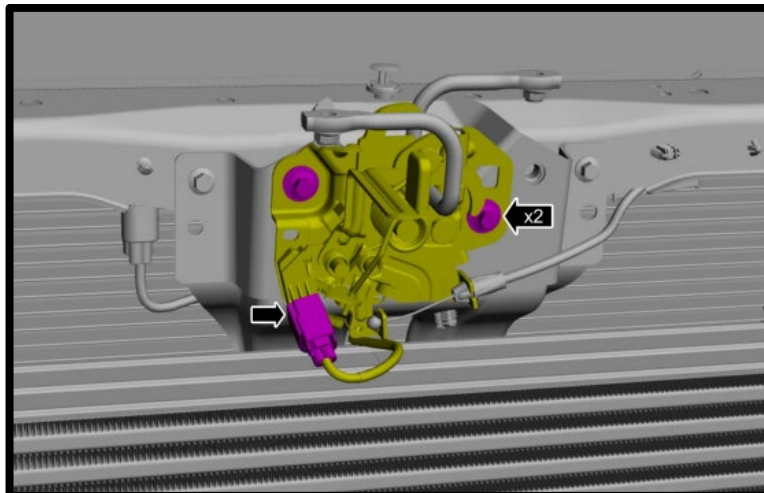
12. RH and LH are similar, remove the fasteners from bottom of intercooler mounts.



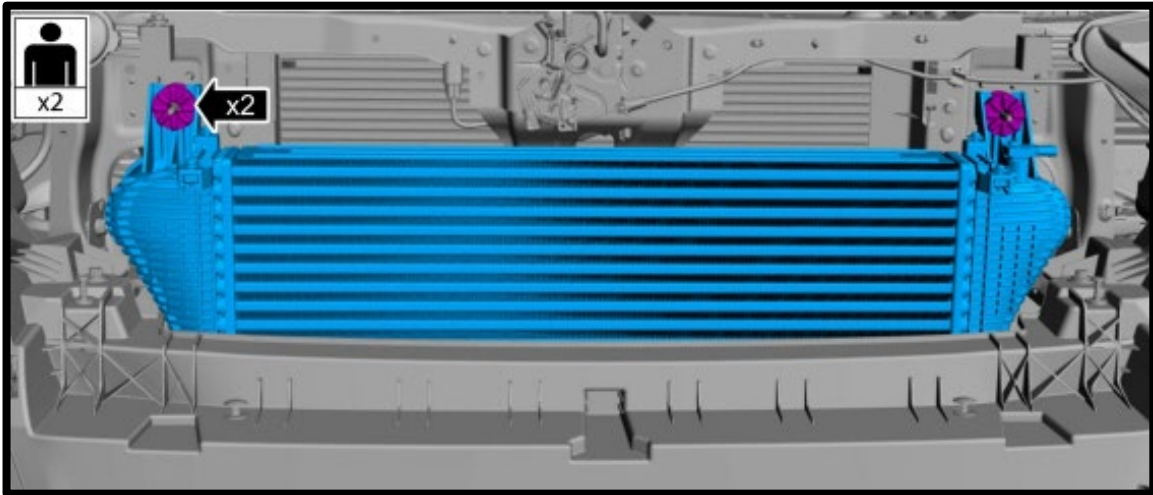
13. Remove the (1) fastener and (1) push pin to remove the hood latch cover.



14. **Mark the position of the hood latch bracket, this will aide in reinstallation.** Disconnect the electrical conner. Remove the (2) fasteners from hood latch.



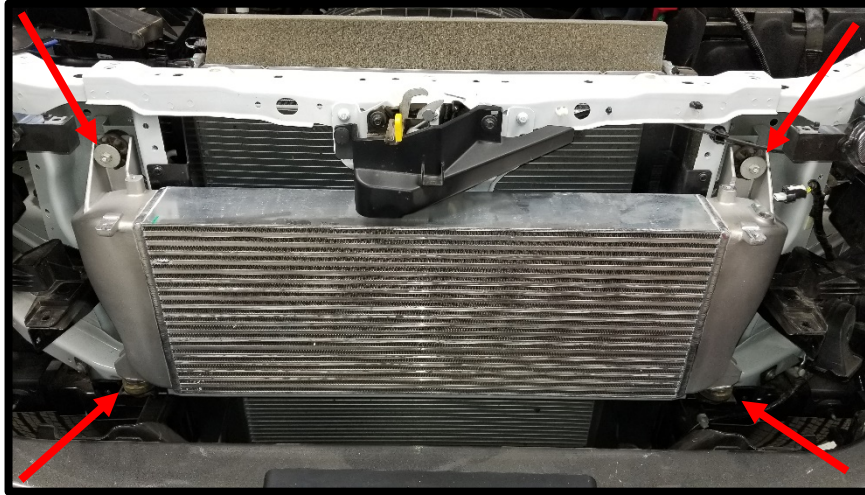
15. Remove the isolators and intercooler from the vehicle.



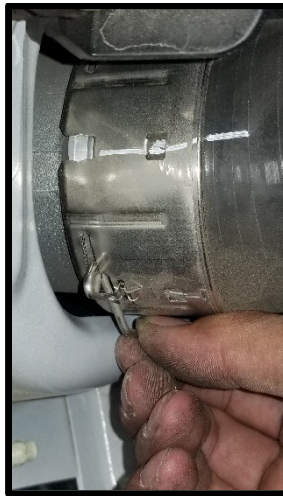
16. Remove isolators from stock intercooler. Transfer to new intercooler core. Install core into factory location.



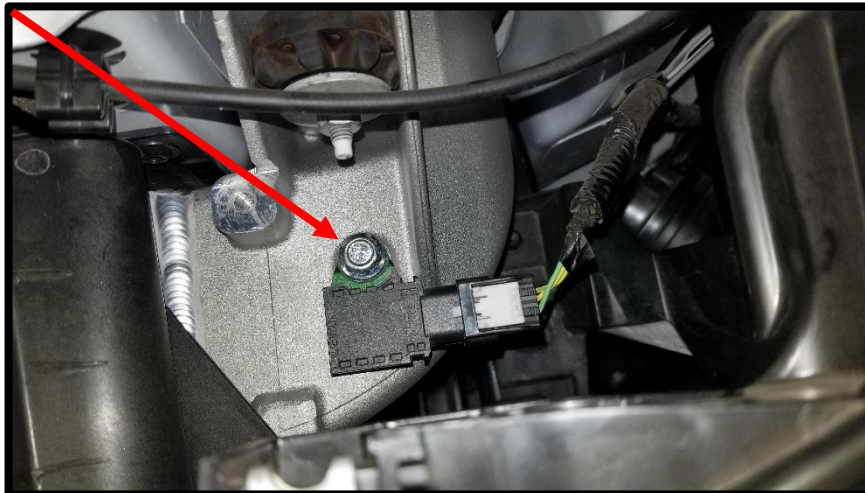
17. Secure new intercooler using the (4) factory fasteners previously removed. Torque to 97 in-lbs.



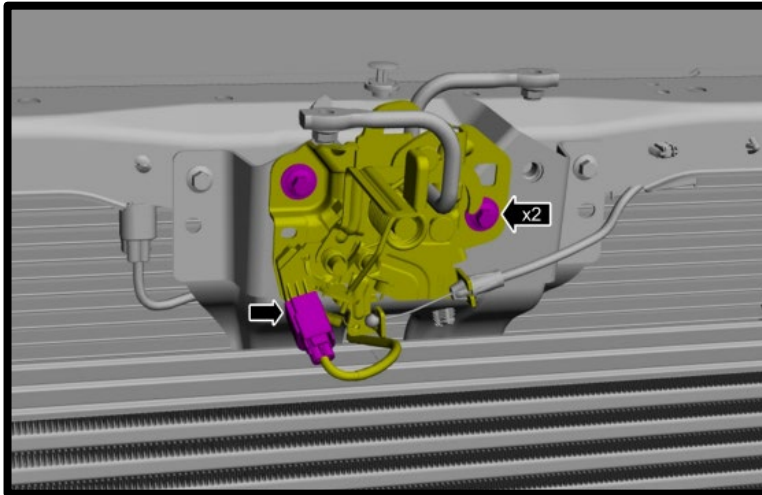
18. Reconnect inlet and outlet pipes using factory connections.



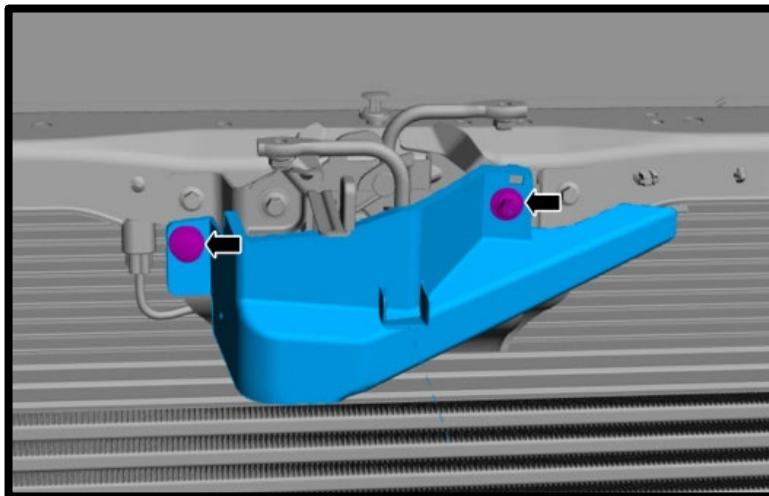
19. Remove the MAP sensor from stock intercooler by removing the (1) fastener. Apply light amount of grease to oring, install to new intercooler using supplied (1) 6mm x 16mm bolt. Reconnect factory electrical connector.



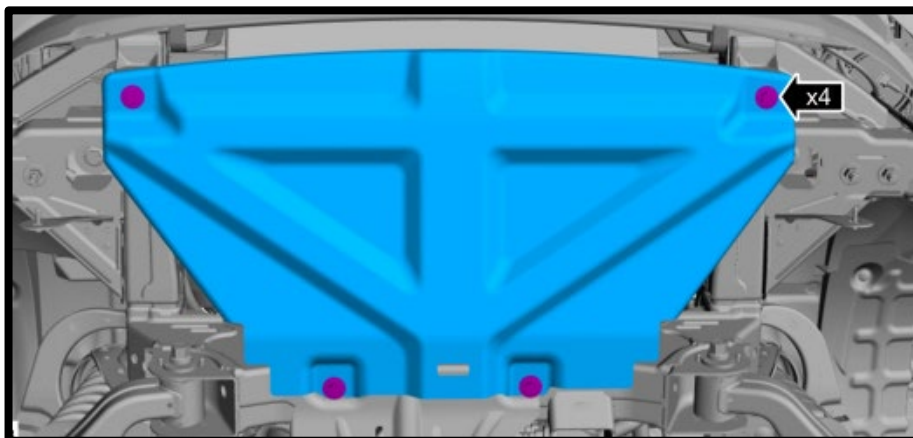
20. Reinstall the (2) fasteners to hood latch. Reconnect electrical connector. Torque to 97 in-lbs.



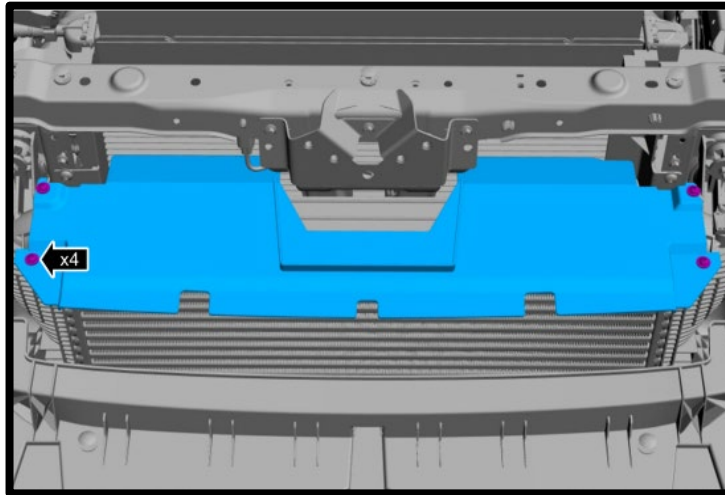
21. Reinstall the (1) fastener and (1) push pin to secure hood latch cover. Torque to 97 in-lbs.



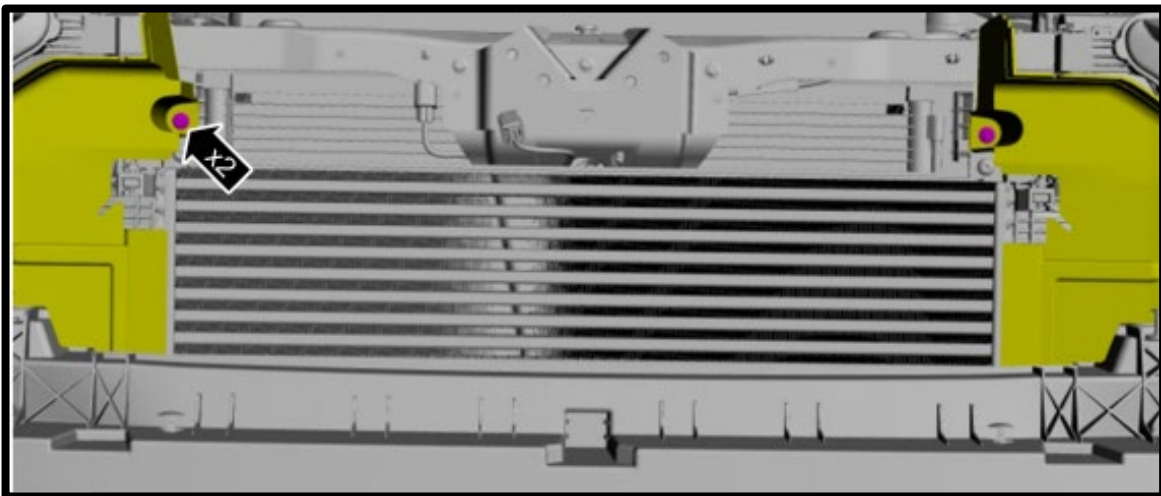
22. Reinstall the (4) fasteners and front skid plate. Torque to 22 ft-lbs.



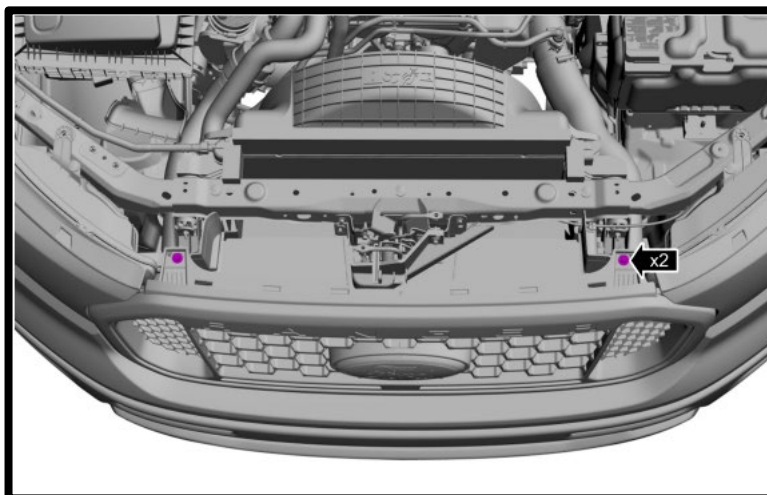
23. Reinstall the (4) screws and the radiator upper shield. Torque to 42 in-lbs.



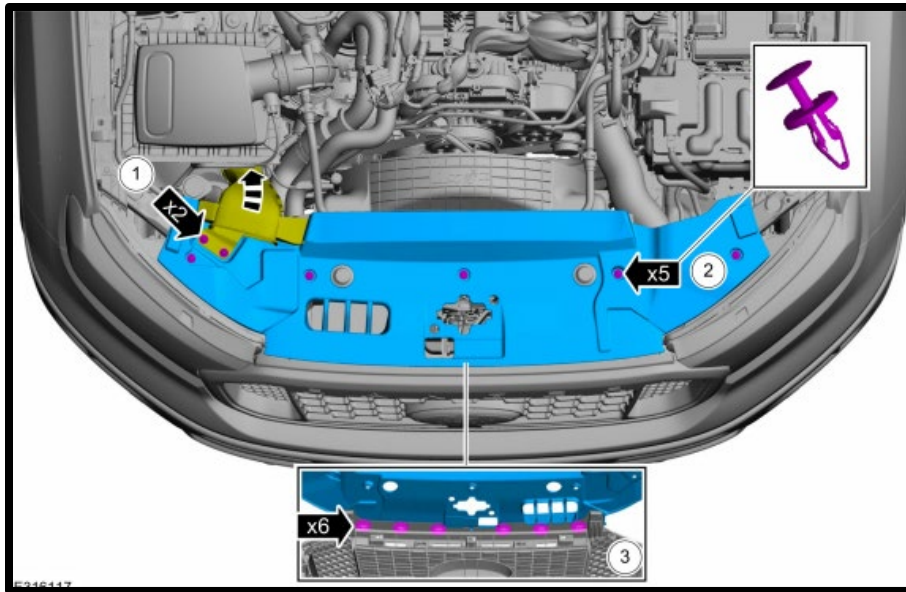
24. Reinstall the (2) fasteners that secure air deflectors. Torque to 42 in-lbs.



25. Reinstall grill. Secure grill using the (2) bolts previously removed. Torque to 44 in-lbs.



26. Reinstall the (5) retainers to secure radiator shield. Reinstall the (2) fasteners to secure air intake duct.



27. Remove the stock air filter, replace with high flow filter element.
28. Install the supplied 50-state legal sticker decal to the underside of the hood, next to the factory emissions sticker. Decal needs to be in visible area. Use light amount of acetone to clean surface before installing.
29. Start the vehicle, check for any leaks or check engine lights.
