

Please read the installation manual and verify that all items are present. If you are missing hardware or have any questions, please contact your dealer or Whipple Superchargers.

RECOMMENDED TOOLS AND SUPPLIES

The following items are not included in this supercharger kit and it is strongly recommended that they're used for ease of installation or maximum performance:

<u>Tools</u>

1/4" ratchet with 4" or similar extension
T20 torx, 3mm allen socket or similar
7mm, 8mm, 10mm sockets
5/16" nut driver or socket
Small wire cutters
Trim removal tool
Flat head screwdriver




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

It is strongly recommended that you read through this guide **<u>before</u>** you begin installing your performance parts.


1. Release the tabs and remove the fuse box cover.




2. Disconnect the MAF sensors, MAF sensor retainers and remove make up air hose from air tubes.



3. Remove the airbox lid bolt using a 10mm socket. Release the locking tabs and remove the airbox lid.




4. Loosen the hose clamps from throttle bodies using nut driver. Remove the air cleaner bolts. Detach the air cleaner boxes from grommets and remove the air cleaner assemblies.



5. Remove the MAF sensor using a 10mm socket. Install factory MAF sensors to the new MAF housing using supplied (4x) 4mm x 10mm SHCS. Torque to 17 lbs-in. ****DO NOT USE STOCK BOLTS**. *NOTE: Verify arrow position for airflow direction.**



6. Using a small flat head screwdriver, remove the clamp securing fitting in air inlet tube. Using flat head screwdriver, remove the stock plastic fittings from air inlet tubes.



7. Install the stock fittings into the supplied inlet tube, orient them in the same stock positions by lining up the gaps.



8. Remove stock airbox snorkel from air cleaner assemblies. Transfer to new airboxes.



9. Install the airbox trim seal pieces to the new airbox top flange. Start in the middle, rear of box for a clean installation. **NOTE:** RH requires trim seal to be shortened 1/2" using cutting shears.



10. Set new airbox with snorkels into factory locations.



11. Set the air filter into the airbox, slide MAF housing through airbox. Slide the air filter over MAF housing. Secure with supplied clamp using 5/16" nut driver.



12. Install new air inlet tube from MAF to throttle body. Leave loose for now.



13. Install MAF housing bracket to airbox, using the (2x per) 4mm x 6mm bolts and 3mm allen. Secure MAF housing to bracket using stock fastener and 10mm socket.



14. Secure air inlet tube to MAF using #80mm hose clamps. Secure air inlet tube to throttle body using #64mm hose clamps.



15. Reconnect factory PCV and fresh air connections to air inlet tube fittings.



- 16. Reinstall factory fuse box cover.
- 17. Reconnect factory MAF sensor connectors.
